There is just one thing that separates you from God - sin. *"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;"* Romans 3:23

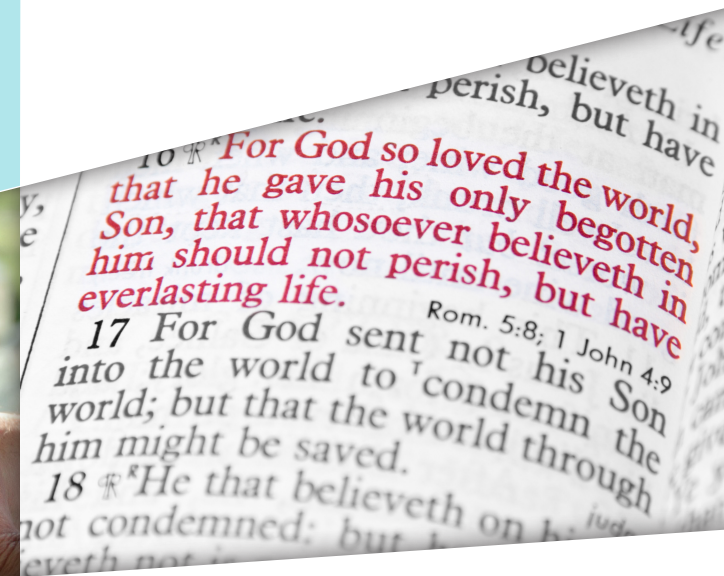
